"WE ARE WEAK AND NEEDY, AND IT WILL BE A HAPPY DAY WHEN WE ADMIT IT."

READ

John 14:1-6, 1 Peter 5:6-7

What are you troubled about? What agitates you, and won't stop? Who has you upset or troubled? Jesus wants us to trust Him and put it all in His hands, so He can work it out. If that is so, then why do we continue to be troubled? We're troubled because we continue to take back those things that we supposedly left in His Hands. We stop looking at Jesus, continuing to drag situations around with us that He's already taken care of, because we feel unworthy, or worry that He hasn't heard us. When we come to Him as a child, He responds as our Heavenly Father. We are weak and needy, and it will be a happy day when we admit it. We don't have to be troubled. We can cast all of our cares on Him, because He cares for us.

PRAY

Lord, it is really hard for me to grasp how much You love me. I'm sorry for worrying. I am happiest when I trust You. Help me to cast my cares upon You and leave them there.
