“SETTLE DOWN. REST IN THE LORD.”

READ

Hebrews 4:1-10

God called Moses up to the mountain and said, “Be there.” Just be there: Don’t bring any tools, don’t bring any agenda, don’t bring any requests. Try to come to God not asking for a thing. Just be in His presence. The Bridegroom is making preparation for us, His bride. I don’t know what our house is going to look like, but it must be something. Oh, that He would deliver us from all of the wrestling. When you go to pray, enjoy the gift of just being there.
