## **“GOD IS LOOKING FOR SERVANTS.”**

### **READ**

*Matthew 20:25-28, 1 Peter 4:10-11*

God wants to show us that when the little and the least trust and obey Him, they will become the greatest and the most. What is inferior to many is what God will use to become superior. That's a Kingdom principle. Jesus told His disciples if you want to be the greatest, you will become the least of all. The world's way to greatness is contrary to God. Whatever the world enjoys, values, or seeks, God says is foolish. Everything God does seems backward, but God has a plan. Jesus tells us that the last will be first, and the first will be last. That simply means that in the Kingdom of God, there are lots of Christians, but not every Christian is a servant. God is looking for people who are willing to serve and not look for what's in it for them. God is looking for those who simply want to please, follow and obey Him. Being a servant is not caring who gets the credit as long as God gets the glory. One of the ways we can be most like Jesus is when we're serving others.
