"IF YOUR DESIRE IS TO PLEASE GOD WITH EVERYTHING YOU HAVE, THEN YOU'RE RAPTURE-READY."

READ

Luke 12:40-48

There is a pull on your soul. It's called the "old man." That old man was moved to the side when the Holy Spirit came into you through Jesus. Since that day, your flesh and the Spirit of God have dwelled inside of you. When I lose the sense of urgency about the day in which I live, or about the limited number of days I have left, I tend to listen more to the old man.
